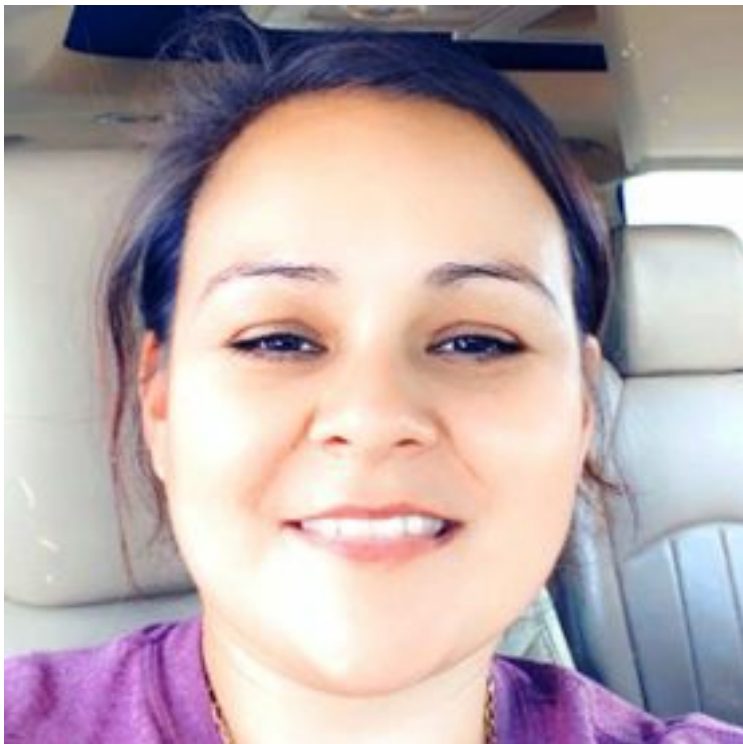
Outdoor Learning

Developmental Highlight

Fine motor skills are budding all over the place in 3-5 year olds! The ability to manipulate items in the hand is achieved by giving children many opportunities to pinch, squeeze, press, and pick up small items with their fingers. In doing so, children gain the strength and ability to firmly and properly hold a pencil and other tools as they begin to write. Our 3 year old preschool students had fun making bracelets by stringing small beads onto pipe cleaners to help develop their fine motor skills.
