Developmental Highlights

Language

Language skills begin to develop in infancy and really blossom and become more sophisticated in the preschool years. Engaging in meaningful conversation with your child is the best way to help develop their language skills. Asking a young child open-ended questions which require more than a yes or no answer and continuing to follow up with deeper questioning as they respond is called a feedback loop and is a wonderful way to stretch your preschooler's expressive language skills and help him/her to develop great questioning strategies of their own.
